

## NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Stoke-on-Trent City Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places in accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013).

In addition, representations are invited from electors within the Borough or the Staffordshire Parliamentary Constituencies, elected members, local political parties and organisations that have expertise in relation to access for people with different types of disability.
