

## **List I and List II discharges and Groundwater Regulations Compliance**

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### **1. List I and List II discharges**

This information is submitted in the context that the Groundwater Directive has been implemented in the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 (as amended) which replaced the relevant Groundwater Regulations<sup>1</sup>.

The latest list<sup>2</sup> of hazardous substances and non hazardous pollutants maintained by the regulator (the Environment Agency) was reviewed in connection with this application.

### **2. Groundwater Compliance - Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016**

Neither the Foundry Site nor the Jubilee site discharges directly or indirectly to groundwater. The Foundry site operates under a discharge consent (Seven Trent Water, dated 27 June 2000, and reconfirmed 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022) with both discharge points entering combined sewers. No trade effluent from the installation is discharged to sewer from the Jubilee site.
