




## WHAT?

First impressions matter – gateways are the first experience people have of the city centre and can be off-putting if they are seen as unwelcoming or poor quality. Improving existing civic spaces will help create a new ‘city centre experience’ and complement the Cultural Quarter and Smithfield, providing current and new residents and visitors with more ‘things to do’.



## HOW?

Improvements to key gateways and spaces will be achieved through public and private sector investment. Change of use and demolition in principle may

be required at key locations to create new opportunity and deliver a phased approach.
